# Deep Prep

## Floor Prep, Burnishing and Gloss Enhancing Cleaner

Sometimes you have to go a little deeper when preparing a floor for burnishing or reconditioning with the appropriate All-Floor System product. Now, there is Deep-Prep. By penetrating the existing coating structure and opening the pores, Deep-Prep extracts and emulsifies embedded soils while conditioning the finish to be burnished to a wet look gloss. This is achieved without the need for aggressive mechanical action, abrasive pads or film destruction.



Once prepared, burnishing with Deep-Prep provides gloss levels even beyond those possible when a finish is brand new! Deep-Prep is phenomenal on badly damaged and soiled rubber sports floors, and is suitable for use on any water-based acrylic or burnishable urethane coating.

**For Deep Scrub & Recoating Applications:** Mix at 8 oz/gal in warm (not hot) water. Apply Deep-Prep to the area to be cleaned using a mop or pressurized sprayer. Scrub the treated area with a 175-350 Rpm buffer or automatic scrubber equipped with a blue pad or brush. Best results will be achieved by double-scrubbing with an automatic scrubber filled with clear water. Extract and rinse on the second pass. Let dry and apply a new coat of either All-Seal or All-Coat as dictated by the material and film thickness requirements.

**For Use as a Pre-Burnish Restorer:** Mix at 8 oz/gal in warm (not hot) water. Spray on floor with a pump sprayer, Fas-Trak Ultra-Spray or through a Fas-Trak Ultra-Trak with microfiber pad. Apply only enough so that it is dry in 3-5 minutes. Once dry, burnish with a Lite Hair, Light Blue or Aqua Burnishing pad as dictated by your equipment and floor finish hardness. The object is to achieve great gloss without swirl marks. Your choice of pad makes the difference.

For Use as a Spot or Area Burnishing Cleaner/Restorer: Floors should be washed prior to burnishing.

Burnish with a Lite Hair, Light Blue or Aqua Burnishing pad and a 1500-3000 Rpm burnishing machine. Apply just enough Deep Prep to moisten the surface of the pad. Using a coarse mist setting apply two squirts of Deep Prep in front of the polisher and begin burnishing. Burnish until Deep Prep has completely evaporated and floor has become slip resistant. **NOTE:** The use of a clean burnishing pad is critical. Pads should be routinely turned over to help eliminate redepositing dirt that has been removed and transfered to the burnishing pad. When pads become soiled either thoroughly clean or discard them.
